LCC's Annual Auction Party on Saturday, September 26, 2026 is fast approaching! Help us make this year's auction fun and successful!!

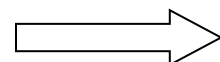
Thank you for helping make LCC's Annual Auction Party a great success!

Whether you host an event, donate a special item or service, or simply join the fun, every contribution supports the ministries of LCC. The information below will help you get started.

★ Host a Fun Auction Event

Looking for ideas? --- a hike and picnic, a class (painting, cooking, singing, etc), an appetizer party or dinner at your home or in LCC's Grove, a treasure or scavenger hunt with prizes, a game or movie night, a tour of a historic site... be creative! These events are fun and bring people together!

1. **Individuals or groups design and host an activity.** The host(s) sponsors the event, covers all the costs involved, and determines the number of participants.
2. **Determine a price for the event.** All the money collected will go directly toward church ministries. Think about what an Auction price should be, balancing costs to keep it within reach for all.
3. **Be clear on the date, price, and number of participants allowed.** All of this information will be collected on the form that you will submit.
4. **A description of the event and cost will be made available in an Auction Catalog which will be sent to everyone by email before the Auction date.** You can look over the catalog before the Auction and plan which events you would like to sign up for.
5. **Create a poster with space for an 8"x11" Sign-Up sheet that we will attach, and bring this poster to church by September 13.** You can leave your poster on Kelley's desk or give it to Marilyn Honegger in worship. This poster will be hung up in Marion Hall on the day of the Auction. There will be designated times during the auction when you can sign up for your favorite events. For those who can't attend the auction, arrangements can be made with someone else attending to sign you up.
6. **The church will collect the money for the events on the day of the Auction.**
7. **Hosts will be given the contact info for those who signed up for the events.** Hosts will then contact the participants with the event details or any changes.



★ Donate a Service or Special Item

Possible suggestions? --- a restaurant gift certificate, a favorite homemade dessert or meal, a weekend or week at your cabin, a spa service, pet care, handyman help, gardening, or another special talent you'd like to share. Personal gifts like these are always appreciated!

1. **Decide on an item or service you'd like to donate.**
2. **Be clear on an accurate description and dates, hours, or other details.**
All of this information will be collected on the form that you will submit.
3. **A description of the item or service will be made available in an Auction Catalog which will be sent to everyone by email before the Auction date.**
You can look over the catalog before the Auction and plan which items and services you would like to bid on. Some of these will be included in the Live Auction and some in the Silent Auction.
4. **Create a poster with space for an 8"x11" bidding sheet that we will attach, and bring this poster to church by September 13.** You can leave your poster on Kelley's desk or give it to Marilyn Honegger in worship. This poster will be hung up in Marion Hall on the day of the Auction. There will be designated times during the auction when you can bid during the Silent Auction and of course there will be bidding during the Live Auction. For those who can't attend the auction, arrangements can be made with someone else attending to submit your bids.
5. **The church will collect the money for the donations on the day of the Auction.**
6. **You will be given contact info for the winning bidder for your service or item.**
